



 This device can only download and install applications that are supported by the device's hardware. To view the hardware specifications, refer to "Specifications".

Overview



No.	Buttons/ connectors	Functions
1	Power button	Press and hold to turn on the device.
	(U)	 When the device is on, press to turn the screen off or on. To turn the device off, press and hold until the Device options menu appears, and then touch Power off.
2	Reset button	Use a pointed object, such as a pin, to push against this button to reset your device when it does not respond to any operations.
3	Volume Down button	Turns the media volume down.
4	Volume Up button	Turns the media volume up.
5	Sensor lock	To fix the screen to current view without auto orientation, slide the sensor lock to the left. To unlock the screen, slide it to the right.

No.	Buttons/ connectors	Functions
6	Microphone	Used for voice recording.
7	Return button	Returns to the previous screen.
8	Menu button	Opens the menu options that you can perform for the current application or function.
9	Home button	Returns to the Home screen.
10	Touchscreen	Displays information and allows you to perform operations using different gestures.
11	HDMI slot	Connects to an HDMI-enabled device.
12	microSD card slot	Insert a microSD/microSDHC card into the microSD card slot to access files stored on the card.
13	USB port	Allows you to connect the device to a computer so the files can be transferred from your computer to the device, and vice versa. (View USB Connections)
14	Speakers	Built-in speakers for playing sounds. Press the Volume Up/Down buttons to adjust the volume of the speakers.
15	Camera lens	Used to take pictures or record videos.
16	Headphone connector	Supports stereo audio signal output to headphones or external audio devices.



Warning:

Avoid prolonged use of the earphones or listening at high volume. Otherwise, your hearing may be damaged.

Charging


Your device is only partially charged when first unpacked. Charge the battery fully for 6 hours before using the device for the first time.



Warning:

If your device is not in use for a long time, the battery will completely run out and may not be powered on immediately even if it is connected to AC power. When this occurs, fully charge your device for 6 hours before use.

- 1. Insert the supplied cable's Type A USB connector into the power adapter's Type A USB port.
- 2. Insert the cable's mini USB connector into the device's mini USB port.
- 3. Plug the supplied power adapter into an electric outlet to start charging.



4. After the battery is completely charged, the battery status icon turns "full" . Remove the power adapter and the cable from both the power outlet and the device.



Note:

Charge your device only by connecting it to a power outlet.
 Connecting your device to a computer is intented to be used for data exchange only. View "USB Connections" for detailed instructions.



Warning: Only use the supplied power adapter and USB cable for charging. Do not remove the cable during charging to avoid possible damage.

Battery status icons

To quickly check the current battery status, refer to the battery status icons displayed on the top right corner of the Home screen.

E	Battery is charging.
	Battery is full.

Warning:

Do not try to replace the battery by yourself. Any attempt to disassemble the device may cause damage to the device or result in personal injury.

Battery maintenance

This device contains a built-in Li-Polymer rechargeable battery. The capacity of the battery will reduce each time it is charged/depleted. However, you can still extend the battery life by following the suggestions below:

- Use the device at least once a week.
- Charge the battery regularly and fully. Never leave the battery fully discharged for a long time.
- Always keep the device away from heat.
- If the device only works when the power adapter is connected, contact your local dealer to replace the battery.

Powering On Your Live Tablet

Press and hold the Power button to turn on your device. You will enter the Home screen after system startup.



Note:

 If the screen is locked automatically, flick screen.

To turn off your device

- 1. Press and hold the Power button (until the **Device options** menu appears.
- Touch Power off and confirm with OK.

To turn off the sound (Silent mode)

- Press and hold the Power button (until the **Device options** menu appears. Touch Silent mode to turn off the sound of the device.
- When the screen is locked, flick down to turn off the sound.



Note:

• To disable Silent mode, touch Silent mode again from the Device options menu, or flick down when the screen is locked.

To turn off the wireless connections (Airplane mode)

- Press and hold the Power button (until the **Device options** menu appears. Touch Airplane mode to turn off all the wireless connections, including Wi-Fi and Bluetooth.
- Touch > Settings > Wireless & networks and check

 To disable Airplane mode, touch Airplane mode again from the Device options menu, or uncheck Airplane mode

Inserting a microSD Card (optional)

Insert the microSD card with its metal contacts facing downwards into the microSD card slot, and push it in until it clicks into place.



To remove the microSD card:

1. Touch > Settings > SD card & internal storage >

Unmount SD card and confirm with OK.

2. Push the card in to eject it from the slot.

Connecting to an HDMI-enabled TV or Monitor (Optional)

You can connect your device to an HDMI-enabled TV or monitor using an HDMI cable.

- 1. Insert the smaller end of an HDMI cable to your device's HDMI port. Ensure that the arrow side faces up.
- 2. Insert the larger end of the HDMI cable to your HDMI-enabled TV's or monitor's HDMI port.
- 3. On your TV or monitor, select the proper input source.



• Refer to the documentation of your HDMI-enabled television or monitor for detailed connections and settings.

Using Your Device

Unlocking the Screen

The screen is locked automatically after powering on, or after the device

is not in use for a preset period of time. Flick direction to unlock the screen.



following the arrow



- To manually turn off the screen, press the Power button .
- To set up the time duration before the screen is off, touch





> Display > Screen timeout.

Navigating the On-Screen Display (OSD) Menus

You can operate the device using the On-Screen Display (OSD) menus. Most of the operations can be done using the touchscreen, while some basic functions or hidden menus can be operated through the buttons.

Using the Touchscreen

Your device provides a multi-touchscreen. Use your finger to touch the surface of the touchscreen to perform most functions. Below are the basic gestures of how to use the touchscreen:

Touch

Touch the screen once to select an item or launch an application.



Touch & Hold

• On the Home screen, touch and hold an item until it magnifies, indicating that it can be moved now.



- Touch and hold any space on the Home screen to open the Add to Home screen menu.
- On the Launcher screen, touch and hold an application icon and it will appear on the Home screen.

Drag & Drop

- 1. Touch and hold an item first.
- 2. Move your finger to a desired position while keeping contact with the screen at all time.
- 3. Take your finger off the screen to drop the item to the designated position.



Flick

Touch and move your finger quickly from one place to another without pause to navigate through the screens, menus, lists, pages, and so on.



Pinch

Place two of your fingers on the screen at once, and spread them apart or move them closer to zoom in or out a picture, a map, or a webpage.







Note:

• You can also double-tap the screen (to touch the screen twice quickly) to zoom in or out a picture, or a webpage.

Adjusting the Screen Orientation

The screen orientation changes automatically to portrait or landscape view depending on how you hold the device. To fix the screen orientation to current view, switch the sensor lock to the left.

Knowing the Home Screen

You will enter the Home screen after powering on the device. The Home screen is the main platform where you can access all the functions and applications installed on your device. You can monitor the status of the device, access webpages, and use widgets to obtain information, or shortcuts to launch applications on the Home screen.

1	Status bar	 status of the device, such as battery power level and Wi-Fi signal strength

2	Screen dots	Touch the small dots on the top left or right of the screen to navigate through the Home screen and the extension screens.
3	Shortcuts	You can customize to add items to any part of the Home screen for quick access, such as application icons, shortcuts, widgets, folders, and so on.
4	Browser icon	Opens the Browser application.
5	Launcher icon	Opens the Launcher screen and views all your applications.
6	Add icon	Opens the Add to Home screen menu.
7	Widgets	Small applications located on the Home screen to provide quick access to useful information, such as the current weather.

Icons in the status bar

The status bar located at the top of the screen provides information about device status, notifications received and the current time.



To view the complete information and perform a task, touch and drag down the status bar to display the ongoing events and notifications listed in the order of the arrival time. Touch each event to obtain further information. To delete the history, touch **Clear**.



1 Notification icons

Notification icons appear when you receive upcoming information, such as new emails, or to inform you about ongoing events or operations, such as when downloading data is in process.



Knowing the Extension Screens

The Home screen also provides 4 more extension screens where you can fill with application icons, shortcuts, widgets, or other items as you like. To navigate across the Home and extension screens, flick your finger to the left or right on the screen.



Customizing Your Screens

You can rearrange, add or remove the widgets or shortcuts on the Home and extension screens. Flick to the screen where you want to customize first.

Moving an item on the screen

- 1. Touch and hold an item until it magnifies.
- 2. Drag the item to the location where you want to reposition it.
- 3. Drop the item.

Adding an item to the screen

- 1. On the Home screen, touch and hold an empty area on the screen until the **Add to Home screen** menu appears.
- 2. Touch to select the type of items:
- Shortcuts/Widgets/Folders: allows you to access a frequently-used item directly from the screen. Flick through the list and touch the desired item to add it to the screen.
- Wallpapers: allows you to change the wallpaper of your screen. Select
 a file source and the desired picture, and touch Save or Set
 wallpaper to set it as your wallpaper.

Removing an item from the screen

- 1. Touch and hold an item until it magnifies.
- 2. Drag the item to the icon on the screen.
- 3. Drop the item.

Using the Applications

All of the applications installed on your device are placed on the Launcher screen.



- 1. Touch and on the Home or extension screens to open the Launcher screen.
- 2. Touch an application icon to start running the application.
- 3. To close the Launcher screen, touch . To return to the Home screen, press the Home button 🚮.

Adding an application shortcut to the screen

- 1. Flick to an extension screen where you want to add an application shortcut.
- 2. Touch it to open the Launcher screen.
- 3. Touch and hold a desired application icon until it appears on the screen, and drag it to your desired location on the screen.

Selecting Your OSD Language

To set the OSD language of the texts displayed on the device, touch





> Settings > Language & keyboard > Select language

and select a desired language from the Locale list.

Using the Android Keyboard

You can use the on-screen keyboard to type texts. Depending on the application you are using, the keyboard layout and the input method may be different.

Touch a text input box to open the Android keyboard.



- **1** Performs the next operation after the text input is done.
- **2** Inserts a space.
- **3** Deletes a character left of the cursor or the marked text.
- **4** Performs the next operation after the text input is done.
 - Touch to switch to the numeric/symbolic keyboard. Touch again to switch back to the alphabetic keyboard.
- Touch and hold to open the options menu:
 - **Android keyboard settings**: to configure the keyboard settings.
 - Touch once to type a sentence with its first letter capitalized (Capitalization).
- Touch twice to type texts with capital letters (Caps Lock mode).
 - Touch the third time to switch back to the lowercase keyboard.
- **7** Touch the letter keys to type the texts.

Managing the input method settings

1. On the Home screen, touch > Settings > Language & keyboard > Android keyboard.

2. To enable a setting, touch to select the check box . To disable a setting, touch again to deselect the check box .

Sound on keypress	Enables a sound on each keypress.
Auto- capitalization	Types a new sentence with its first letter capitalized.
Input languages	Selects a desired input language.
Quick fixes	Marks and corrects the wrong spellings.
Show suggestions	Displays possible combination of words as you type.
Auto- complete	Touch the spacebar or punctuation keys to insert a highlighted word automatically.


Securing Your Device

You can protect your device data with a screen unlock pattern, or a password.

On the Home screen, touch > Settings > Location & security > Set up screen lock.

Protecting your device data with a pattern

- 1. Touch **Pattern**. Read the instructions on the screen and touch **Next** to continue.
- 2. Study the on-screen animation on how to draw the example pattern, and touch **Next** to open the pattern drawing screen.



- 3. Drag your finger to draw your personal unlock pattern by connecting at least 4 dots in a vertical, horizontal and/or diagonal direction. Touch **Continue**.
- 4. Draw the pattern again as requested, and then touch **Confirm**. Your personal unlock pattern is remembered by your device.



Note:

• To change or disable the screen unlock pattern, you will need to draw the old pattern for safety confirmation first.

Changing or disabling the screen unlock pattern

- 1. On the Home screen, touch > Settings > Location & security > Change screen lock.
- 2. Draw the current pattern your created.
- 3. To change the pattern, touch **Pattern** and follow the steps in "**Protecting your device data with a pattern**" to reset the pattern.
 - To disable the pattern, touch None.

Protecting your device data with a password

- 1. Touch Password.
- 2. Enter your own password, which should consist of at least 4 characters and contain at least one letter, and then touch **OK**.
- 3. Enter the password again for confirmation, and touch **OK**.



• To change or disable the screen unlock password, you will need to enter the old password for safety confirmation first.

Changing or disabling the password

- 1. On the Home screen, touch > Settings > Location & security > Change screen lock.
- 2. Enter the password you enabled, and then touch **Continue**.
- 3. To change the password, touch **Password**, and follow the steps in "**Protecting your device data with a password**" to reset the password.
 - To disable the password, touch None.

Connectivity

Wi-Fi

To browse the webpages, send emails or use other Web applications, connect the device to the Web first via a wireless network.

Connecting to a Wi-Fi network

1. On the Home screen, touch > Settings > Wire

networks and check Wi-Fi 🗸 to turn the Wi-Fi on.

- 2. Touch **Wi-Fi settings**. The device then scans for available Wi-Fi networks. The network names (SSID) and security settings of discovered Wi-Fi networks display in a list.
- 3. Flick through the list.
- If your desired network is in the list, continue to step 4.
- If it is not discoverable, touch Add Wi-Fi network. Type the network name, select its security type and enter the password, if needed. Touch Save.



Note:

- To start a new search for the available Wi-Fi networks, on the Wi-Fi settings screen, press the Menu button and touch **Scan**.
- 4. Touch a desired network from the list. Enter its password, if needed, and touch **Connect** to start connection.
- 5. After the device connects successfully to the Internet, the appears in the status bar indicating the current Wi-Fi signal strength.



• To disconnect from the current Wi-Fi network, touch its name from the list, and then touch **Forget**.

Identifying network notifications

The device notifies you automatically whenever a new open network is available, and will display the a icon in the status bar. To stop

receiving notifications, touch | > Settings | > Wireless &





networks > Wi-Fi settings, and uncheck Network notification



Bluetooth®

To exchange data with other devices, use the Bluetooth technology to connect your device to other Bluetooth devices within a distance of approximately 10 meters (30 feet). Before the connection starts, you need to turn on your device's Bluetooth radio. To be connected by other Bluetooth device, you may also need to make your device "discoverable". When you are not using the Bluetooth function, be sure to turn it off to extend your battery's life.

Connecting to a *Bluetooth* device

1. On the Home screen, touch > Settings > Wireless &





networks and check *Bluetooth* \checkmark to turn the *Bluetooth* on. The





ightarrow icon then appears in the status bar.

- 2. Touch **Bluetooth settings**. The device automatically scans for the available Bluetooth devices. The discovered devices appear in a list.
- 3. Flick through the list. Touch to select a desired device. You will now need to pair your device with it to build the connection.



Note:

- To start a new search for the available Bluetooth devices, touch Scan for devices.
- If your desired device is not available, its "Discoverable" function may have been disabled. Turn on this function of the device to pair first.

4. You may be prompted to enter or confirm the same password on both devices to authenticate. The password may be set manually or provided by the manufacturer. Touch Pair and follow the on-screen instructions to complete the pairing process.



Note:

- Refer to the documentation of the paired device for the detailed operations and the default password, if needed.
- 5. After the pairing is successful, the Paired but not connected message appears under the paired device. You can now transfer data from and to the paired device.



Note:


- Once a device is paired successfully, next time you can simply connect to the paired device for data exchange.
- Depending on the type of the paired devices, the messages of successful pairing may be different. For example, if you are connecting to a headset, the pairing message shows: Connected to Phone Audio or Connected to phone and media audio, and



the kind icon appears in the status bar.

Sending files to a paired *Bluetooth* device

- 1. Locate the files you want to share with the paired device. Touch and hold the file to open the options menu.
- 2. Touch Share > Bluetooth and then touch the name of the paired device from the *Bluetooth* device picker to start data transmission.
- 3. Flick down the status bar to monitor and confirm the transmission result in the Notifications list.



Editing the device name and making it discoverable

- 1. On the Home screen, touch > Settings > Wireless & networks > Bluetooth settings > Device name to edit the device name. Touch OK to confirm.
- 2. On the *Bluetooth* settings screen, check **Discoverable** . When within range, other *Bluetooth*-enabled devices can find your device from the *Bluetooth* devices list.


Unpairing a paired device

- 1. On the Home screen, touch > Settings > Wireless & networks > Bluetooth settings. From the Bluetooth devices list, touch and hold the name of a paired device to open the pop-up menu.
- Touch Unpair or Disconnect & unpair to end the pairing partnership. The next time you want to restore connection with this device, you will need to pair with it first.

USB Connections

You can copy personal or downloaded files from your computer to the device's internal memory, or to the microSD card inserted in the device, or vice versa.

- 1. Insert a microSD card into your device's microSD card slot.
- 2. Insert the supplied cable's mini USB connector into the device's mini USB port (a). Insert the cable's Type A USB connector into your computer's Type A USB port (b).



- 3. The USB connected page appears on the screen.
- 4. Touch **Turn on USB storage**. Your computer will recognize the device memory and the microSD card as two removable drives (Windows systems) in the following sequence: the device's internal memory, the microSD card storage.



Note:

- After you turn on the USB storage function, your device can not recognize the files stored in the microSD card.
- 5. On the computer, copy desired personal files from another drive/ folder to your desired removable drive.



Warning:

Do not remove the microSD card from the device or break the USB connection while copying files.

6. When done, touch Turn off USB storage.



Note:

 You can also enter the USB connected page by dragging down the status bar, and touch **Turn off USB storage** from the list of the ongoing events.

- 7. From your computer, click so on the desktop toolbar. Click the popup message that reads "Safely remove USB Mass Storage Device", and select the removable drive of your device.

Contacts

In this application, you can store contacts with a variety of business and personal contact information in your device to provide quick and easy access to reach them.

On the Home screen, touch > Contacts





Adding new contacts

Editing, sharing, or deleting contacts

- If you have set up an account from other applications, for example,







To view your frequently visited webpages or your browser history

- 1. Touch the Bookmarks icon 📮 to the right of the URL box.
- 2.To view your frequently visited webpages, touch the **Most visited** tab. The webpages appear in a list. Flick down to go through the list.
- 3. To view your browser history, touch the **History** tab. To find a visited webpage, touch the day when you last visited the webpage, and then flick through the list to locate it.

To use web links

Move to a link you want on a webpage. The links may be displayed in the form of an URL address, an underlined text, a picture, or an email address. Touch and hold the link to display the options menu. you can open the link in new window, bookmark, save or copy the link, or share the link via *Bluetooth* or Email.

To install a downloaded application

In order to protect your device and personal data, installing applications downloaded from the Web or received with an email message is prohibited by default. To enable it, allow your device's download feature of web applications.

Your device provides the optimal experiences of browsing and playing back various multimedia files whether stored on your microSD card, received from Email or other Bluetooth devices, or downloaded from the Web. Before using the following applications, ensure the files you want have been copied to the microSD card inserted in the device.

- To learn how to download files from the Web, refer to "Downloads from a webpage".

Camera

In this application, you can take pictures or record videos using the device's built-in camera.



Taking a picture

- 1. Touch to enter Camera mode.
- 2. Focus the object you want to capture in the viewfinder screen.
- 3. Touch the on-screen Shutter button. The picture just taken will be displayed on the top right corner in a thumbnail.

- 4. To stop recording, touch the on-screen Stop button. The first image of this video just taken will be displayed on the top right corner in a thumbnail.

In this application, you can view the current date and time or weather information, if available, and set an alarm, start a picture slideshow, or play back audio files.

- If you have set up more than one email account, you can view and synchronize multiple calendars.

Creating an event

- 1. Press the Menu button , and touch More > New event to open the Event details page.
- 2. Fill in the fields using the on-screen keyboard as described below. Touch **Done** when finished.

Viewing the calendar

The calendar can be displayed in daily, weekly, monthly, or agenda view.

Press the Menu button to change the calendar view using the options below: **Day, Week, Month**, and **Agenda**. Flick the screen to view the previous or next day, week or month. To return to the current month, touch **Today**.



Note:

- While viewing the calendar, you can:
 - In any calendar view, touch an event to view details about the event.
 - Touch and hold an event to open a pop-up menu, and select to view, edit or delete the event, add a new event, or switch to Day or Agenda view.

Viewing and synchronizing multiple calendars

In this application, use the on-screen calculator to perform standard arithmetic calculations.

To adjust the volume

Touch Volume to open the Volume setup window. Touch and drag the scroll bar to adjust the volumes of notification, media (audio and video) playback and alarm sounds. Touch **OK** to confirm.

To enable various sound effects

- To enable sounds upon receiving notifications, touch Notification ringtone > Default ringtone > OK.
- To enable feedback sounds when making a screen selection, or when locking and unlocking the screen, check Audible selection or Screen lock sounds.

Display settings

Touch **Display** to configure the following settings.

Brightness	Touch and drag the slider to adjust the brightness. Touch OK to confirm.
Auto-rotate screen	Check this function to enable automatic screen orientation.
Animation	Displays animation when open and closes windows

Screen timeout	Sets the time duration before the screen is off.
TV Mode	Sets a desired TV out mode.
TV Resolution	Sets a desired TV resolution.

Restoring your device

To restore your device to factory default settings, touch **Privacy** > **Factory data reset** > **Reset device** > **Erase everything**.

Date and time settings

Touch Date & time.

To manually set up the date and time

- 1. Uncheck Automatic.
- 2. Touch **Set date**. Touch + / to adjust the date, and then touch **Set**.
- 3. Touch + / to adjust the time, and then touch **Set**.
- 4. To set the time and date display format:
 - Check or uncheck Use 24-hour format.
 - Touch Select date format to select a desired option.

Troubleshooting

Problem: The device does not respond to any operations.

Solution:

- An internal error may have occurred. Use a pointed object, such as a pin, to push against the Reset button to reset your device.
- The battery is depleted. Charge the device first.

Problem: Your computer does not detect your device when connected.

Solution:

- Check if the USB cable is connected firmly and correctly onto both the device and your computer.
- Remove the USB cable, and then reconnect the device onto your computer using the USB cable.

Problem: The screen orientation of the device does not change as I rotate the device.

Solution: The automatic screen orientation function may be

disabled. Slide the sensor lock to the right to enable this

function.
